#### Comprehensive Answer Questions:

17. Read the following case carefully and answer the questions that follow:

WeHelp Nepal is a non-government development organization (NGO) which is established with the objectives of providing equal learning opportunities and educational resources for the Nepali children, especially those who are underprivileged. Its general objective is to uplift the education status of poor and needy children of Nepal. Specifically it aims to make children acquire formal education, for which it has student sponsorship program. To make children able to enhance skills through various education related activities, train and facilitate teachers and educators through training programs, seminars and workshops for raising the professiona skills of them so that they can contribute in helping the children become confidence and face the future challenges successfully. However, its prime focus is to establish IT centers in the areas where people are deprived of the IT skills or facilities.

Since its establishment in the year 2012, Wehelp Nepal has initiated four IT center in Nepal. These centers are equipped with 20 laptop computers each with internet facilities. The children as well as other members of community could use the facilities with a minimum charge of NPR 15-20 per day as maintenance charge. The number of users of these IT centers is significant and many schools and communities are asking for such centers in their localities.

The evaluation of the IT centers indicates that the IT centers though run successfully, they may not be sustainable. So, WeHelp Nepal, with consolation of its board of directors and donor agencies changed its policy. Thus, from non-on the community or the schools which seek to establish an IT center in their areas need to find a local agency as partner of WeHelp Nepal and contribute thirty percent of the establishment cost of IT center. Likewise, the school or community must also contribute ten percent of the cost. Together with this each center should provide NPR 2000 each year to WeHelp Nepal fund which will be a contribution to establishment of the new IT center. Many of the stakeholders welcomed this new idea however, some are against it. And some even raised question about the utility of IT centers as they said that in some places they found that the users have not been engaged in its intended objective of enhancing educational skills and knowledge but merely using it as a "cyber-Café" playing games.
